Code of Conduct

- ★ Keep all alleyways and gate areas clear – no spectators in hitching ring.
- ★ Horses are to be walked to and from the ring - mounted or dismounted - NO RUNNING.
- ★ No slapping and/or disciplining your horse in an aggressive manner.
- ★ Do not leave your horse - tied or loose - unattended at any time.
- ★ No riding your horse in the ring when grounds people are setting up or taking down equipment.
- ★ Young children must be supervised at all times.
- ★ No cussing.
- ★ **NO Alcohol** on the show grounds.
- ★ If there is a problem with a horse and/or rider, please report to any executive member.
- ★ Proper footwear (Western or English) should be worn at all times.
- ★ Please use arena etiquette as follows:
 - ★ Pass left to left
 - ★ Pass on the inside (unless in a circle where faster horses go to the outside)
 - ★ No stopping on the rail
 - ★ Watch for others behind you when slowing down or stopping
 - ★ Keep a safe distance between horses - minimum of one horse length.
